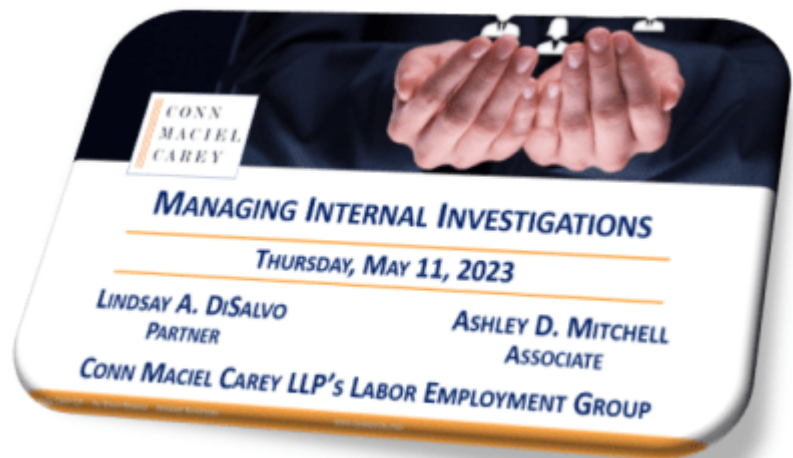

## Managing Internal Investigations [Webinar Recording]
