In addition to OSHA's myriad *Safety* regulations, the agency has also promulgated approx. 30 comprehensive *Health* standards, and established air exposure limitations for an additional 500 common chemicals present in U.S. workplaces, such as asbestos, lead, and silica. Knowing when and how to conduct monitoring is complex, and the chemical sampling data collected can be a double-edged sword. [This webinar](#) helped employers understand and comply with the requirements of OSHA's occupational health standards, provided useful guidance and tips on the types and frequency of air monitoring or other chemical sampling that may be required at your facilities, and the programs to implement if you do experience exposure levels above the minimum

regulatory thresholds (or other industry consensus thresholds).
